

Barnwell County, South Carolina, Register of Mesne Conveyances, Deed Book 8-G:241, Angeline Reed to Lucia Lott, 29 September 1911; Clerk of Court's Office, Barnwell.

Abstract

I, Angeline Reed of Barnwell County, South Carolina, in consideration of \$8000 convey 94 acres to Lucia Lott of Barnwell County, South Carolina, "known as my Holly wood plantation but originally known as the James O Mims tract who acquired title from his Mother Sarah A. Mims." Bounded as follows

 "On the North by lands of J. T. Youngblood,

 On the East by lands of J. D. Whittle and Mrs JR. Mims,

 On the South by the Old Charleston Road separating it from lands of BO. Stansell and

 on the West by lands of Mrs S.A. Owens formerly S. S. Owens land and lands of Mrs L.E. Woolly."

The same land is involved in "the action entitled R J Mims et al Vs Angeline Reed & Brigham Reed in which a Verdict of the Jury was rendered in favor of the defendants" on 6 April 1908. The verdict was signed by W.H. Hartzog, Foreman [?].

Reed to withhold possession of land from Lott until Reed "can gather Crops and [two words illegible] with other personal property" but not later than 1 January 1912.
